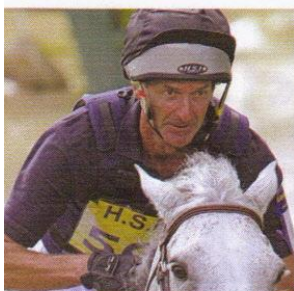


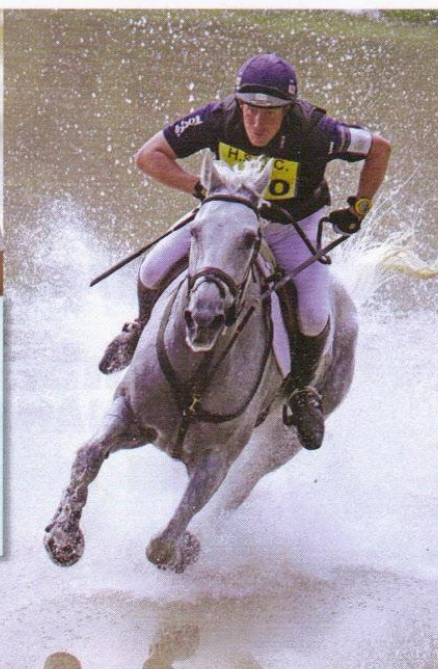
IN THE FRAME

We were blown away by the entries for our Amateur Photographer competition in which Nigel Wilkinson's dramatic shot of Oliver Townend took the top spot



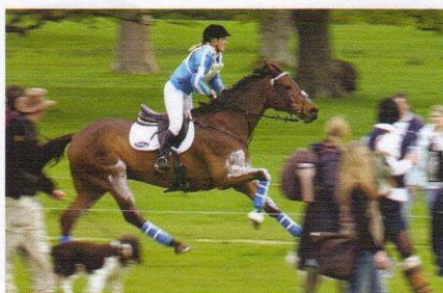
FIRST

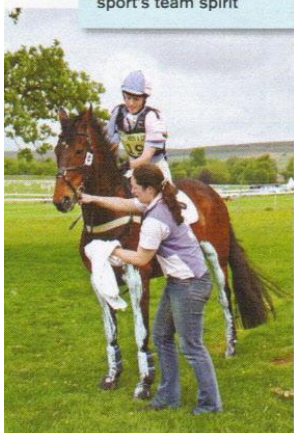
BEST SCENE
