IN 2007 Clifton Lush fell in the field and broke nine thoracic vertebrae — in other words, his withers. He was not allowed to lie down or roll for six months and, Jock says, is 2in shorter than before his accident.

"He has no wither now and there's not a lot in front of you when you get on, but he's this little horse who just pins his ears back and goes for it," The 13-year-old New Zealand thoroughbred
