## Ros Canter.

Horse: Allstar B, 12 **Breeding: Ephebe For** Ever x Ekstein Owners: Caroline Moore and rider Best result: fifth Badminton CCI4\* 2017

Form: Ros makes a deserved senior squad debut after being best of the Brits at Badminton this spring and several strong CIC3\* results with Allstar B. This pair can reliably deliver a low to mid-40s dressage score and showiump well, but previous four-stars had been marred by a run-out across country.



### Tina Cook,

Horse: Billy The Red.

Breeding: Balou Du Rouet x Stan The Man xx Owners: Elisabeth Murdoch and Keith Tyson Best result: 10th Badminton CCI4\* 2017 Form: Billy The Red has been carefully produced and sprang into the limelight when second in the Olympic final trial at Bramham last year. He went to Rio as travelling reserve and finished ninth on his four-star debut at Pau. Tina was European champion in 2009.



## Piggy French,

Horse: Quarrycrest Echo. 10 **Breeding: Clover Echo** x Cavalier Royale Owner: Jayne McGivern Best result: second Tattersalls CCI3\* Form: Quarrycrest Echo was ridden by Tina Cook last year while Piggy was on maternity leave and few would have thought this pair were up for selection six months ago; second at Tattersalls, with a personal best dressage of 39.3, put them in the mix. Piggy's best Europeans result is individual silver in 2009.



### Gemma Tattersall, 32

Horse: Quicklook V, 12 Breeding: Urkel x Ouickstar Owners: The Pebbles Syndicate Best result: first Chatsworth ERM CIC3\* 2017 Form: "Pebbles" showed her greenness in Rio with a sub-par dressage and two stops across country. However, she has come out and ticked all the hoxes this season; on her best form she would be an individual medal contender. This is Gemma's second Europeans - she was an individual in 2015.



### Oliver Townend, 34

Horse: Cooley SRS, 10 Breeding: Ramiro B x Kiltealy Spring Owner: Angela Hislop Best result: first Ballindenisk CCI3\* 2016 Form: Oliver comes to his fifth Europeans and was a team gold medallist in 2009 and 2011. Cooley SRS has been a consistent performer through the levels, with six top-10 CIC3\* results

### Sarah Cohen, 43 Horse: Treason, 15

**Breeding: Hand** In Glove x Welton Crackeriack Owners: Preci-Spark Ltd and Elizabeth Jones Best result: first Jardy ERM CIC3\* 2017 Form: Treason is Sarah's only eventer and after 12th at Burghley 2016 she has targeted the Event Rider Masters this year, with consistent results. If she were to run, this would be Sarah's senior squad debut - she went to Athens 2004 but had to withdraw when The

Wexford Lady was

injured after arrival.



## Sarah Ennis,

Horse: Horseware Stellor Rebound, 13 Breeding: VDL Ricochet x unlisted Owners: Horseware Products LTD. Niki Potterton and Orla Fnnis Best result: first Chatsworth CIC3\* 2017 Form: an experienced pair who have plenty of top-three CIC3\* results, including a recent second at Kilguilkey. They have four-star form too. including 32nd at Badminton this year with 20 jumping penalties across country. This is Sarah's

second Europeans.



### Joseph Murphy, 41

Horse: Sportsfield Othello, 16 Breeding: Ricardo Z x Ring Of Forde Owners: rider's wife Jill, Alison Schmutz and Andrew Tinkler Best result: 13th Badminton 2017 Form: this pair have had some strong results, including fifth at Pau CCI4\* in 2014. although Joseph fell off on his last team duties at the Blair Europeans in 2015. Now at his fourth Europeans, Joseph is likely to be a little off the pace in the dressage, but could be a useful team contributor.



# Michael Ryan,

Horse: Dunlough Striker, 12 Breeding: Maltstriker x Beau Royal Owners: Carol and Tom Henry Best result: won Millstreet CCI3\* 2017 Form: Dunlough Striker comes to his first senior championship, while Michael is riding at his fifth Europeans, They had one stop across country on the horse's first four-star at Badminton this spring for 38th. They have a decent three-star record in the jumping phases, but their dressage isn't really competitive.



## Patricia Ryan,

Horse: Dunrath Eclipse, 11 Breeding: Chinook Eclipse x Rame Z Owners: Carol and Tom Henry Best result: 25th Luhmühlen CCI4\* 2017 Form: Patricia, who is at her third Europeans, and Dunrath Eclipse have solid rather than exciting form, including a mid-field completion at the horse's first fourstar recently. While they are consistently recording mid to high 40s dressage scores, time-penalties across country tend to be their downfall.

### Austin O'Connor, 42

Horse: Kilpatrick Knight, 12 Breeding: Master Imp x Golden Trump Owners: Eugene McKenna and Wendie Foster Best result: 26th Badminton 2017 Form: Austin is another experienced rider (fifth Europeans) partnering a championship debutant horse. Kilpatrick Knight was unlucky to miss out on Rio after second at Tattersalls CCI3\* last year. Austin will want to repeat the bestever dressage (40.5) the horse showed recently at Barbury.
